

Where can I eat?

The department has taken the following considerations for determining if it is safe to allow maskless eating in an area:

- For single-occupancy rooms: Can the door be shut?
- For multiple-occupancy rooms: Is there substantial air circulation? Can tables be spaced 6-feet apart with egress space?
- 20-minute limits apply to all shared eating areas.
- 1-person at fridge/sink/counter/microwave at a time.
- Sanitize before/after using: table/chair, microwave buttons, fridge handle, sink, and anything touched.
- In common areas: do NOT move tables and chairs around.
- In shared office areas people can be maskless for 5 minutes or less, to have a coffee, cold drink, or snack.
- If you have a private office with a door that shuts, please eat there to free up shared eating spaces for those in shared desk areas.
- Can you eat in a procedure room with the door shut? No.

4 th Floor Atrium	2 people with 6-foot distance.
JHN	20-minute limit all spaces
Kitchen	1-person, shut the door.
PAA	20-minute limit all spaces

Occupancy limits are maskless eating limits, not meeting/working limits.
