² Confocal microscopes: Leica SP5 II laser scanning confocal microscope on an inverted stand, Nikon A1R HD25 laser scanning confocal microscope, Olympus IX81 with DSU spinning disk confocal microscope, and Yokogawa CSU-X1 spinning disk confocal microscope

³ On the confocals and OMX, sessions after 6PM and before 9AM, weekends, or with duration longer than 6 hours, that is from the 7th hour onward, will be charged at extended rate.

⁴ Sessions longer than 3 hours, that is from the 4th hour onward, will be charged at extended rate.

⁵ This is a surcharge to the hourly rate of the equipment. Microscope training usually consists of two 3-hour sessions and other equipment training can be 30 min. to an hour.
